Different essential things are being provided to Utkal Balashram, Child care units, orphanage, old age houses, disabled children, help to deserted persons, handicapped persons, higher studies of poor but scholars, etc.

FEED BACKS AND HIGHLIGHTING ACTIVITIES OF DISTRICT RED CROSS BRANCH, JAJPR FOR STATE LEVEL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING FOR THE YEAR 2021-2022.

Besides, providing regular financial assistance to the needy, poor, deserved and serious patients, the District Red Cross Branch, Jajpur has been taking up various commendable services and significant activities for the cause of the society.

- Since Blood is the vital organ of the human body and requires for operation cases, accident cases, thalasamia patients, etc., extensive Blood Donation camps are being conducted by District Red Cross Branch with the cooperation of Ashok Das Foundation. 1635 Units of Blood have been collected by organising 34 nos. of Blood Donation camps in the year 2021-22.
- Remarkable Achievements have been done by DRC by bringing 4 nos. of labourers in village Jamadhar under Jajpur Block who have breathed their last by fire accident in a Textile Factory at Gujurat State and providing immediate Financial Assistance @ Rs. 10,000/- each on humanitarian ground on the spot. Secretary, DRC was also present during cremation of the dead bodies.
- Another remarkable achievements done by DRC with cooperation of JRC volunteers by supplying drinking water (Sweet curd water) and lemon water to the polling personnel during dispersal days and election materials collection days during last General Election.
- Whenever Road accidents are occurred, DRC Branch immediately provides Financial Assistance as a gesture of humanity.
- Financial Assistance are also provided for transportation of Dead bodies from the Hospitals to their destinations including cremation for those who are very poor and who have nobody in the society to perform their rituals.
- Financial Assistances have been provided to the needy, poor and orphan students for their Higher studies. Some examples:-
 - (i) Saraswati Sahu, D/o- Indramani Sahoo of Atia, Kusunpur, Rasulpur has been given Rs. 35,000/- for higher study as she is an orphan girl.
 - (ii) Sonu Nayak, S/o- Managobinda Nayak of village Kapileswar has been given Rs. 30,000/- for continuation of his ITI course.
 - (iii) Rukmani Behuria, D/o- Ramesh Ch. Behuria of Bibisarai has been provided a Bi-cycle for her to and fro journey to Adarsa Vidyalaya, Jamadhar, Baruhan from Jajpur Town as her father was died and she is very poor.
 - (iv) Jyoti priya Sahoo, D/o- Fakir Sahoo was given Rs. 84,000/- for her Nushing traning at Cuttack.

- Rs. 1,53,99,747/- was received as donation in the financial year 2020-21 from different sources and organizations voluntarily and the expenditure incurred was donation in the year 2021-22 and expenditure made Rs. 94,58,912/-.
- Rs. 400/- (Rupees four hundred) is being disbursed to each Aids (HIV) patients per month for their medical checkup and purchase of nutritious food for 30 nos. of HIV affected persons.
- Some medicines for serious disease are not available in Niramaya medicine stores in the Hospitals. Those medicines are purchased from open market by Medical Authority, the cost of which are borne by DRC. Rs. 5,87,657.00 was given during financial year 2021-22.
- Everyday needy and serious patients are coming and Rs. 59,98,321/- (Rupees Fifty nine lakh ninety eight thousand three hundred twenty one) only was provided for their treatment during the finance year 2021-2022.
- One TV set has been given to Jajpur Jail for entertainment of the prisoners for financial year 2021-22.
- One Aquaguard water cooler has been provided to Biraja women's College for the financial year 2021-22 for supply of safe drinking water to the students.
- One Rudra Madhab Samal was working at Hariyana State and he was suffered from Cancer disease. His financial condition was very miserable. No one was there to look after him. On the request of his wife Smt. Riturani Samal at Sankunal, PS- Mangalpur her husband was brought from Hariyana and the cost of the ticket amounting to Rs. 40,000/- was arranged by DRC. Besides, Rs. 20,000/- was also given for cancer treatment at Odisha. Now the patient is cured and in well condition.
- YRC at College level are observing various social service occassions like Road Safety, Aids day, World Health Day, etc. Four nos. of Cluster level volunteer study-cum-Traning camps have been organized in Kharastrota Mahavidyalaya, A.P. College, Sujanpur Jhadeswar Degree College at Tolkani and Biraja Women's College, Jajpur with a view to motivate the Youths from the tiny age towards self less service in the society.
- JRC at the High School Level are also observing different occasions like World Health Day, Road Safety by organizing different competitions among the High School students. JRC Councillor training camp has also been organized from 21.3.2022 to 22.3.2022.

Untrained office of JRC have been given training during 2021-2022.
