6. State Level YRC Study-cum-Training Camp:

State Level YRC Study-cum-Training Camp was organized at Nilachal Polytechnic, Pathargadia, Bhubaneswar from 6th to 8th February, 2024. Three Hundred YRC Volunteers and Counsellors from 28 districts and Bhubaneswar region have participated in the Camp.

Volunteers were oriented on Red Cross, Road Safety, Volunteerism through Youth Red Cross, Social Service Through social media, Career Counselling, HIV/AIDS, Disaster Survival Skill, First Aid, Massive CPR Training etc., along with Yoga. Shramadan Human Chain, Talent hunt, Cultural programme, Site seeing were also organized during the camp.

Nutrition food packets were distributed like: Cerelac , Lactogen (3,4) Posan (Horlicks), Protein power for Pregnant ladies and baby feeding Mothers to avoid the Malnutrition . We also support NAN PRO to Twins of Nepal village on 16th February,2024 by IRCS,OSB. The remuneration @ Rs. 1,000/- each were given to the lady teachers for taking class (educational class) for the children of Nepal village. During distribution of nutrition materials the Local village Sarapanch , Ward member, Asha Didi and Anganwadi Worker participated in the distribution programme.
