1. Observance of World Red Cross Day, 2024

Indian Red Cross Society, Odisha State Branch was observed the World Red Cross Day on 8th May, 2024 in the memory of the great philanthropist Sir Jean Henry Dunant, the founder of Red Cross. Theme of the Day was – “**Keeping Humanity Alive**”.



To mark the day, dry foods like biscuits, cake, fruits, juice, bread etc. were distributed at Prativa orphanage, Jadupur and Ramakrushna Balashram, Chandaka. On request from the Secretary of Ramakrushna Balashram, a refrigerator was donated to the Ramakrushna Balashram.



To mark the day a blood donation camp was organised in association with Global Focus Education and Welfare Trust. Near about 70 units of blood were collected from the camp.



A state level meeting was conducted at Red Cross Bhavan premises. Sri Bibhuti Bhusan Pattnaik, Honorary Secretary of IRCS OSB emphasizes the work of Red Cross like first aid, relief etc. during disasters and how to work as a volunteer for the benefit of society. The Youth Red Cross Officer Dr. Ramesh Chandra Behera highlighted the work of Youth Red Cross and Junior Red Cross for rendering humanitarian services through empowering volunteers.
